SUBJECT: USE OF ELECTRICAL EQUIPMENT IN DISTRICT FACILITIES

In accordance with Education Law 807-a all schools will be inspected annually by authorized fire inspectors for fire hazards which might endanger the lives of students, staff and visitors to the school. Any deficiencies noted in this report must be responded to by the Board of Education within thirty days of such notice.

In addition, New York State Commissioner's Regulations Section 155.7(g) states, "Electrical Equipment and auxiliary apparatus and controls, and instillation and use of same, shall be such as will insure safe operation in accord with applicable recognized standards, as determined by the Commissioner, and be consistent with efficient energy consumption."

Therefore, all electrical equipment used in any District facility, including classrooms, offices, lounges, garages and other District property, will be in compliance with fire regulations and Commissioner's Regulations. All electrical equipment will be issued and approved by the District. Electrical appliances brought in from the outside will be permitted only with District approval.
