## I Have a Positive Home Test... What Do I Do?

### Preferred Method:

- Fill out the online form found on the St. Lawrence County Public Health Department (SLCPHD) website (<https://stlawco.org/Departments/PublicHealth>) or use this link directly: <https://forms.gle/a9sgoACGFUcU9p8w5>.

### Alternative Method:

- Call the St. Lawrence County Public Health Department at 315-386-2325.
  - If it is after hours, please call: 315-454-2363.
- Take a picture of the test and then throw the test away.
- Send the picture to SLCPHD either via text to 315-454-2363 or via email at [SLCCOVID19SharedMailbox@stlawco.org](mailto:SLCCOVID19SharedMailbox@stlawco.org).
  - Be sure to indicate the name, date of birth, phone number, and test date in your message.

### \*With Either Method\*:

- Someone from Public Health or the NYS Contact Tracing team will reach out to you for an interview. Please be advised that you may receive a call from 518-387-9993 (NYS Contact Tracing) to complete the interview. We attempt to reach every case within 48 hours, depending on case volume.
- Notify your school district of the positive test results.
- The COVID-19 positive individual should self-isolate at home and away from other household members, if possible. If separation is not possible, those with repeated exposure may be subjected to a longer quarantine period
  - For anyone living in the household:
    - Unvaccinated household members will be required to quarantine and should begin to self-quarantine now.
    - Fully vaccinated household members (at least 14 days from their final dose at the time of exposure) will only need to quarantine if they are experiencing symptoms.
    - A contact tracer will still be calling them for an interview to verify vaccination status and symptoms.
      - In the interim, those who are fully vaccinated and asymptomatic can remain at work/school.
  - SLCPHD will only provide quarantine documentation to those who are subjected to a Mandatory Quarantine – if you are fully vaccinated, asymptomatic, and exempt from quarantine, you will not receive documentation.
