SUBJECT: INDEPENDENT EDUCATIONAL EVALUATIONS

Parents of children with disabilities have the right under Federal and State regulations to obtain an independent educational evaluation (IEE) at public expense under certain conditions. Eligibility for an IEE at public expense shall be determined in accordance with federal and state regulations, and administrative regulations and procedures. Copies of these documents are available from the District for parent(s) who desire additional information.

A parent is entitled to only one (1) IEE at public expense each time the District conducts an evaluation with which the parent disagrees.

The Board of Education directs the Superintendent or his/her designee to develop administrative regulations in order to explain the rights of parents and the responsibilities of the district with regard to independent evaluations.
