Dear Parents/Guardians:

One of the greatest joys of childhood is waking up in the morning to a fluffy white coating of snow on the ground and the news of a snow day. The surprise day off is a special treat, often filled with sleeping in, snowmen, sledding, and hot cocoa.

The district now has an option to utilize fully remote instruction in place of snow days. We will begin by using traditional snow days in case of inclement weather. As the winter settles in, we will monitor our use of snow days and use fully remote snow days if it is necessary. We currently have five (5) snow days built in for the 2022–2023 school year, and if we decide to utilize a fully remote day in place of a traditional snow day, we will make that clear on our closing notifications.

The district uses the ParentSquare notification system to provide timely communication to parents and staff members regarding delays and cancellations as well as other district emergencies. When school is closed for the full day, it is also communicated to local television stations, including WWNY-TV Channel 7. When a decision is made to close school, all other after-school activities scheduled are also cancelled.
